Real Life Stories:

Envision educators visit many grade 7 - 10 classrooms in Southeast Saskatchewan, talking about healthy relationships.

Students learn about consent and the risks of sending sexts or pictures on a phone.

"I learned rape can be considered rape even if the person doesn't say no out loud." – gr. 10 girl

"I learned you can get charged and have to register as a sex offender if you have nude pics of a girl under 15 on your phone." – gr. 10 boy

A mother of two seeks Envision Counselling to attempt to leave her husband. Her wounds aren't visible on the outside, but she's deeply injured from years of abuse. After counselling, she makes a plan and follows through. Envision continues to support her during these changes in her life.

In time, she goes on to fulfill her potential, becoming a healthier mom, a happier employee, and an active member of the community.
